

**Campfire checklist**

---

**Confirmation open campfires are allowed at the site**

**Waterproof "Strike-Anywhere" kitchen Matches**

**Lighter**

**Shovel: or folding camp shovel, or garden hand-trowel**

\*even if you are using a fire-ring and don't need to dig a fire pit or enclosure trench, or need to cover your ashes, this tool help spread the ashes when you are putting out your fire.

**Water Container -** \*at least 32oz., more is better, even up to a 5-gallon bucket for large campfires. This is what you will use for fire-control emergencies and to extinguish the coals.

**Fire Starter - commercial or home-made**

**Firewood - tinder/kindling/large wood**

**Ax or Hatchet or Camping Saw -** \*If you have pre-cut firewood available to use, these may not be essential, (as long as your pre-cut includes tinder and kindling), but they are still very handy to have at hand around any campfire.
